For one week in September the Memorial Museum in Sighetul Marmatiei will be host to 30 students (BA, MA, PhD) who come together to debate the new theoretical and factual acquisitions relating to the history of Romanian Communism.

This year's topic will be Between the Soviet Model and National Characteristics and will be focused on a comparative approach with the hope that future historians will better understand Communism and its East-Central European context.

In 2017 the Autumn School is open for students and researchers, both from Romania and for those living and working in other former socialist states in Central and Eastern Europe (Poland, Hungary, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Bulgaria, etc.).
