On the Doctoral School in Philosophy

Following the reorganization of doctoral studies in Philosophy under the Regulation no. 23160 from 21st of October 2011 of Babeş-Bolyai University that relate to organization and coordination of the doctoral studies, the Doctoral School in Philosophy was established by the unification of hitherto existing doctoral schools within the Faculty of History and Philosophy.

DSPh comprises annually over 50 Ph.D students and over 20 professors, scientific advisors and affiliated teachers as mentors. Inside the DSPh PhD can be conducted in Romanian, Hungarian or in a foreign language with international usage.

The preparation of doctoral students in the domain of philosophy, as scientific doctorate is oriented in the following main research directions: phenomenology, semiology, hermeneutics, ethics, aesthetics, political philosophy, philosophy of culture and communication, history of philosophy, studies of ancient and medieval philosophy, Romanian or Hungarian philosophy. Doctoral studies in the DSPh are oriented to research characterized by applicative, inter- and transdisciplinary profile.

Doctoral studies in the DSPh are organized in accordance with the scientific work of didactic cadres and doctoral students and they are held in two research centers: the <u>Center for Ancient and Medieval Philosophy</u> and the <u>Center for Applied Philosophy</u>. Such facilities provide technical and material sources of information and documentation necessary for research, good quality coordination and guidance.

DSPh members are involved in several international research projects, they maintain national and international institutional collaboration with other scientific and professional doctoral schools, research centers and academic institutions in the country and abroad. Their findings are presented in conferences, symposiums, workshops and in numerous scientific publications in journals and publishing houses agreed and indexed in BDI. Annually scientific sessions are organized for doctoral students, a Supplement of the Studia UBB is published annually gathering scientific doctoral publications. Students can receive doctoral research scholarships at universities abroad and through their teaching duties they can obtain experience in teaching activity.

Due to sustained efforts of DSPh members and that of the research centers to create favorable conditions for doctoral students to conduct research, original, meaningful and valuable theses are completed.
