# Digital skills in higher education. The state of play in the field of European Integration Studies

The Jean Monnet Module Digital teaching and learning in the field of EU Integration Studies in the new member states(D-Skills) launches a call for papers for the workshop *Digital skills in higher education. The state of play in the field of European Integration Studies*. The event is hosted by the Department of International Studies and Contemporary History, Faculty of History and Philosophy, Babeş-Bolyai University.

It aims to foster a forum of discussion, where academics from new, old and EU candidate states have the opportunity to exchange ideas and share best practices on teaching approaches and methods in EU Studies.

## **Background**

The 2015 Yerevan Ministerial conference has placed teaching as the core objective of the European Higher Education Area, 'stressing that enhancing the quality and relevance of learning and teaching is the main mission of the EHEA' (Yerevan Communiqué, p.2).

The use of digital technologies is one of the methods that can boost the quality of the teaching process and the EU has adopted in the last years' several key documents with the aim to support and guide the member states in building digital learning environments. *The Digital Education Action Plan* or the Communication from the Commission on a renewed higher education agenda are representative in this direction.

New impetus for digital skills-based educational dimension was also reinforced through the VdL EU Commission agenda which aims to make the European Educational Area a reality by 2025.

## Format of the workshop

We welcome applications from junior and senior academics of EU Studies and Political Science, in particular on the following topics:

What digital technology policies and strategies have the universities developed to respond to the strategic policies adopted by the European Union?

What kind of policies do universities have in place to train and professionalize the teaching staff to use digital technologies in the teaching and learning process?

How is the EU Integration curricula designed to implement the Digital Competence Framework 2.0 across?

How are EU Integration courses taught across disciplines? How are digital technologies embedded to cultivate critical thinking and digital instruments for civic participation in an era of fake news?

What innovative pedagogies are used in the teaching process? What tools are associated to provide students with the skills necessary for the labour market?

### Submission

Interested researchers are invited to submit an **abstract of 250-300 words** and a short bio by filling out the <u>Application Form</u> available at the following link: https://jmdskills.com/call-for-contributions-may-2022/

#### **Publication**

The dissemination of the results of this workshop will be published on the project's website as open educational resources.

Depending on the quality of the papers, the organizers are planning to publish the papers in a collective volume or as a special issue of an international peer-reviewed journal.
