





Dublin IV. - The neverending story

- None of the previous regulations were ready to handle the rapidly increasing number of asylum applications from 2014.
- In 2014. 11. 01, the new President of the European Committee, J-C. Juncker set out 10 new priorities, one of them to forge a new European migration policy.
- The work has been started, but various MSs had various perspectives on migration.
- Readmission, relocation mechanism, safe country of origin, safe third countries, EU-Turkey Deal
- Solidarity and burden sharing became the buzzwords for the reform
- 2020. 09. 23 The Commission proposed a new Dublin IV.

Overview

❖ Main challenges:

- ❖ Instability in the neighboring regions (especially the Middle East, North Africa)
- ❖ Isolationist policies promote illegality, burden the welfare state and, especially in the case of refugees, are in conflict with values promoted
- ❖ Assaults and acts of terrorism promote fear of foreign infiltration in the population and are exploited by certain individuals to restrict the rights of migrants/foreigners (-> securitization?)
- ❖ Conflicts within Germany and the EU lead to shifts in the political system¹⁵
- ❖ Government has little room for maneuver in migration policy through Europeanization and public opinion¹⁶



Case study - social inclusion of Roma in the EU



Although more than 20 years have passed since EU states confronted members of the Roma minority who migrated to the West, social inclusion measures have not yielded the expected results (in fact, many countries have real problems to integrate their own citizens belonging Roma minority), possibly due to the following factors:

- ❧ lack of education;
- ❧ mentality deeply rooted in conventional traditions and concerns (pastors, craftsmen)- which leads to the mismatch of available jobs;
- ❧ opposition to change and a certain opposition to work;
- ❧ lack of education;
